After being gone for six months, the cupola atop Savannah City Hall was returned Thursday. It took all day for work crews to attach the 16-foot-high adornment to the top of the building's dome. Technically, it is a replica of the original cupola, which was too weatherdamaged to be retained. The cupola project is part of a \$2.1 million building renovation that should be completed by the beginning of June, city officials have said.
